RBT

Read the Bible Together

RBT is the whole church listening to God speak to us. Over three years we will read the whole Bible. During each month we read a book (or several shorter books) in our own time with our eyes and minds open to hear what the living God is saying.

After reading the book we will get together and share with one another what the Holy Spirit has revealed. The RBT meeting takes place the week *before* the First Sunday of each month. We will be encouraged, strengthened and challenged by God's Word through each other.

Find out more information in the the RBT leaflet. This will also show you the questions we use each month to help us in our reading.

We anticipate this being a way in which our Father guides St George's Church as we follow Jesus together.

The following Sunday – the First Sunday of each month – will often have a sermon that builds on what God has been saying through RBT.

If you only make one mid-week meeting each month, make it this one!

The Holy Scriptures are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
