A Prayer from Metropolitan Philaret

O Lord, grant me to greet the coming day in peace. Help me in all things to rely upon Your holy will. In every hour of the day reveal Your will to me. Bless my dealings with all who surround me. Teach me to treat all that comes to me throughout the day with peace of soul and with firm conviction that Your will governs all. In all my deeds and words guide my thoughts and feelings. In unforeseen events let me not forget that all are sent by You. Teach me to act firmly and wisely, without embittering and embarrassing others. Give me strength to bear the fatigue of the coming day with all that it shall bring. Direct my will, teach me to pray. Pray Yourself in me.

Most Holy God, I pray and beseech You, give me a pure heart, a way of speaking that befits the faith I profess. Grant me uprightnes of purpose, powers of reasoning unhindered by passions, conduct that becomes those who fear You, and perfect knowledge of Your commandments. May I enjoy health in body and in spirit.

Grant me a life of peace, genuine faith and living hope, sincere love and bountiful generosity, patience that knows no bounds and the light of Your truth to proclaim Your goodness to me, that for ever and in all things placing my trust only in You, I may abound in every good work, and that in Christ Your gifts may increase in every soul.

A Prayer of Commissioning

Father God, You have adopted us
as Your daughters and sons:
 help us to live as children of light
 bringing glory to Your holy name.

Jesus Christ, You suffered and rose again for us:
 teach us to seek first Your kingdom
 as we deny ourselves, take up the cross
 and follow You.

Holy Spirit, You stir us to love and good works:
 strengthen us to fight against sin,
 the world, and the devil
 so that Your will, not ours, may be done.

Father, Son and Holy Spirit, You have saved us:
 send us into the world
 to proclaim Your gospel. Amen.

Heavenly Father,
I worship You as the creator
and sustainer of the universe.

Holy Spirit, I worship You, sanctifier of the Church.

and to the Holy Spirit.
Heavenly Father, I pray that I may live this day
in Your presence and please You more and more.
Lord Jesus, I pray that this day I may
take up my cross and follow You.
Holy Spirit, I pray that this day You will fill me with
Yourself and cause Your fruit to ripen in my life: love,
joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness,
faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

Prayer at the End of the Day

Grant that, though our bodies grow weak, we may increase in spiritual strength; so that, entrusting ourselves to Your care and mercy, we may accept Your will and at the last enter into the joy of Your eternal kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

A Prayer to God The Father

A Prayer to God the Son

O Almighty Lord, Word of the Father, Jesus Christ, who Yourself are perfect, for the sake of Your great mercy, never depart from me, but dwell in me forever. O Jesus, Good Shepherd of Your sheep, deliver me from the attacks of the evil one. Lord Jesus Christ, Holy King, keep me while I sleep in the unchanging light of Your Holy Spirit, the Spirit with which You sanctified Your disciples. Enlighten my mind with the light of understanding Your holy Gospel, my soul with the love of Your Cross, my heart with the purity of Your Word, my body with Your sacred Passion, my senses with Your humility, and awaken me at the proper time to glorify You. For You, above all, are always to be adored, together with Your eternal Father and Holy Spirit, now and ever and forever. Amen.

A Prayer to God the Holy Spirit

O Holy Spirit, most merciful Comforter: You proceed from the Father in a way we cannot understand. Come, I ask You, and dwell in my heart. Purify and cleanse me from all sin, and sanctify my soul. Cleanse it from every impurity, water its dryness, melt its coldness, save it from the paths of sin. Teach me humility that I may be pleasing to You, that You will dwell in me forever. Most blessed Light, comforting Light, enlighten me. Joy of paradise, fountain of delight, my God, give Yourself to me; kindle within me the fire of Your love. My Lord, instruct, direct and defend me in all things. Give me strength against all my fears and keep me from despair. Give me a faith that is real, a firm hope, and a sincere and perfect love. Let me always do Your most holy will. Amen.

The Lord's Prayer (use your preferred version)

For the kingdom, the power,
